

Proceeding of the Ironwood City Commission

A Regular Meeting of the Ironwood City Commission was held on March 26, 2007 beginning at 5:30 P.M. in the Commission Chambers, Second Floor of the Municipal Memorial Building in the City of Ironwood.

A. Mayor Noren called the meeting to Order at 5:30 P.M.

B. Recording of the Roll.

C. Approval of the Consent Agenda.*

- *1) Approval of Minutes – March 26th Regular City Commission Meeting.
- *2) Authorize advertisement for bids on Manhole Relining for the CDBG Project Area.
- *3) Authorizing Request for Proposals (RFP) for annual audit services for the year ending June 30, 2007.

Motion was made by Kasieta, seconded by Adams to accept the Consent Agenda as presented. Unanimously passed by roll call vote.

D. Approval of the Agenda.

City Manager Erickson addressed the City Commission reminding them about the Budget Workshop scheduled for Wednesday, April 11, 2007 at 4:00 P.M. in the Women’s Club Room at the Memorial Building.

Commissioner Koivisto questioned if there was a possibility the City of Ironwood could pay for the Alfred Wright Blvd. Project out of the fund balance and get reimbursed at a later date when the grant becomes available. Manager Erickson noted if the City of Ironwood is successful with the Local Jobs Today Program the Alfred Wright Blvd. Project could be moved up to 2008. Further discussion of this matter took place.

H. Commissioner Comment. (Five Minute Limit).

Commissioner Kasieta recommended the Department Heads, City Manager, and the City Commission participates in the free CPR class being held at the Grand View Hospital on April 17th.

Commissioner Adams questioned Finance Director Frederickson regarding the contribution to the Heritage Trail. City Manager Erickson informed the City Commission he would look into this matter further.

Mayor Noren questioned the 9-1-1 matters and the City of Ironwood. Mayor Noren noted it is not unique to just Ironwood residents. He further noted it is unique to the geographic area and the Iron County Tower.
